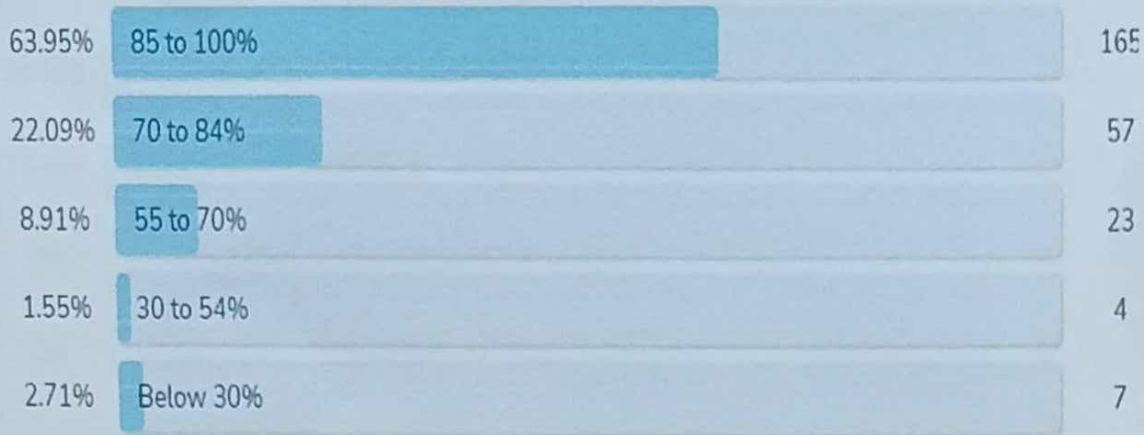

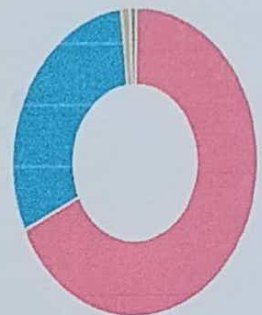
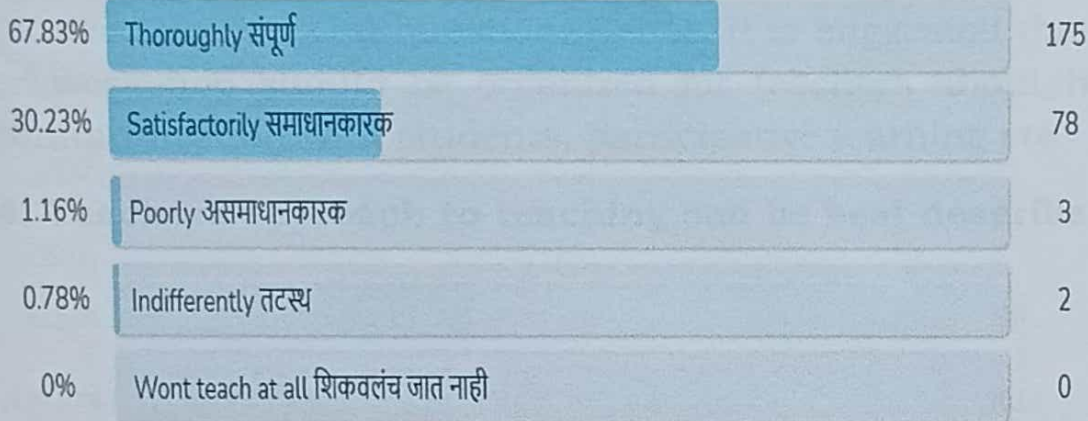


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

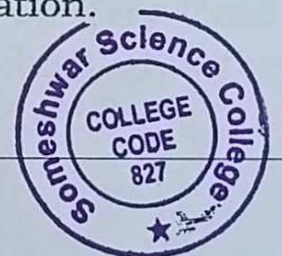


Analysis and Comments: Considering the replies, more than 86% students have confirmed that more than 70% syllabus is covered in the class and by any yardstick this is a good achievement considering the Covid pandemic.

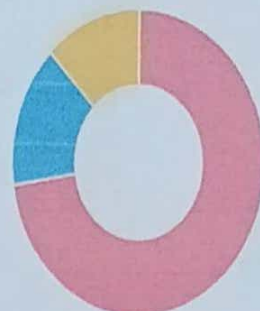
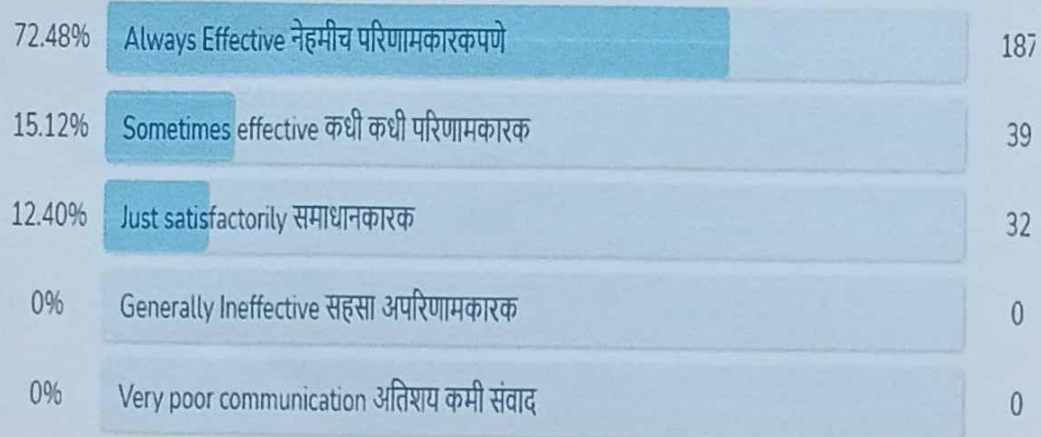
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the class?



Analysis and Comments: One fine teacher commented that it may happen that a bad student may not understand what a good teacher is trying to teach but he does know whether the teacher is well prepared to teach the topic or not. In this regard, the an overwhelming majority of students (nearly 68%) have expressed that their teachers are thoroughly prepared before they conduct the class. This underlines the commitment of the teachers in the college in imparting good quality education.



3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

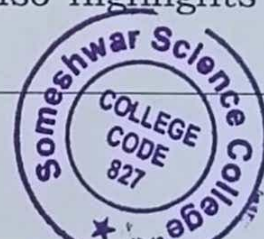


Analysis and Comment: More than 72% students have confirmed that teachers from the college are always effective in communicating with the students. Though none of them have reported that the teachers are generally ineffective in communicating with students, still it is felt that the college should pay attention to the 28% responses where the students have felt that the effectiveness of the communication needs to be increased. This fact is also ascertained from the descriptive responses received for the 21st question. Hence, it is suggested that special sessions or workshop should be organized for teachers about having interactive communication with students, participative learning etc.

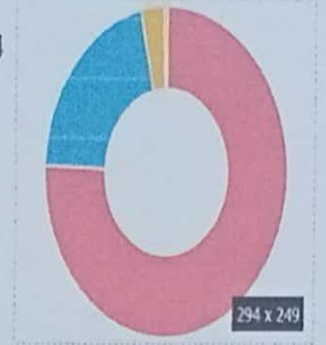
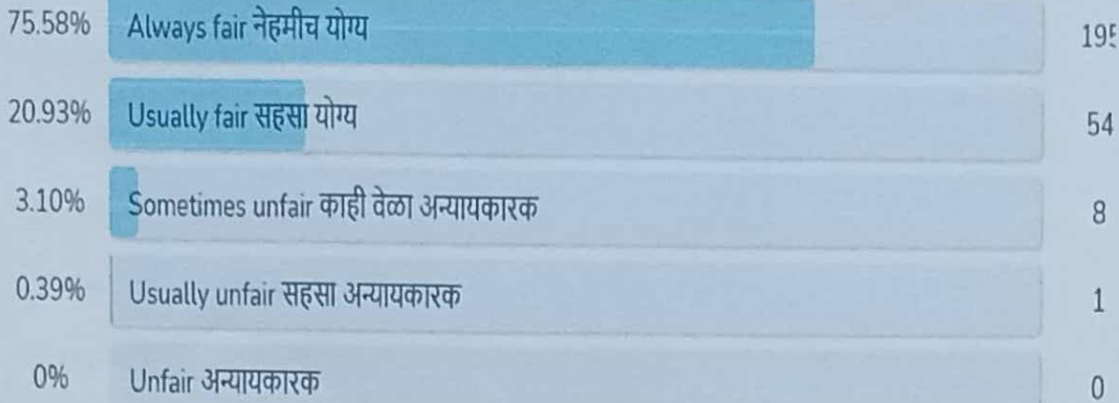
4. Teachers approach to teaching can be best described as

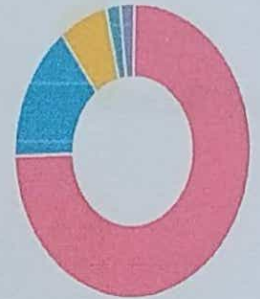
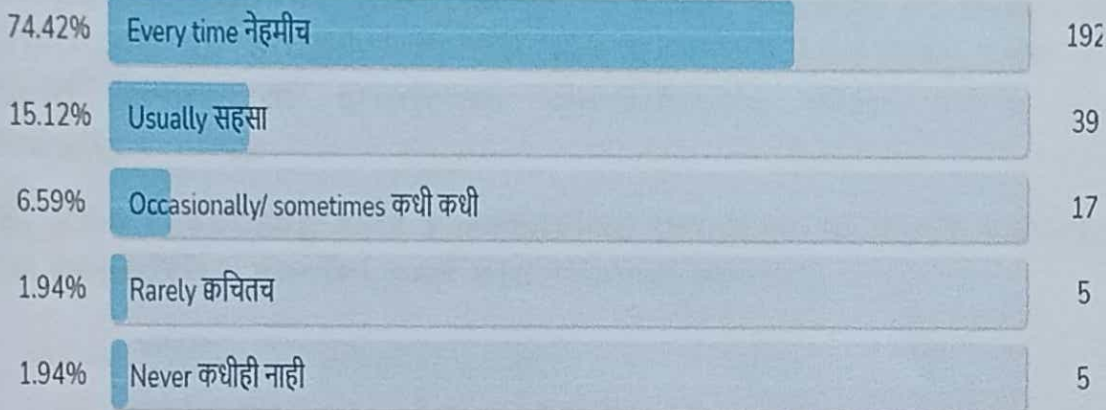


5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:

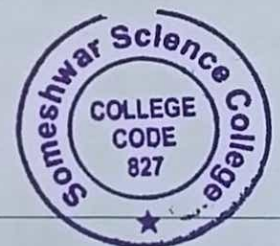


Analysis and Comments: An overwhelming majority of more than 96% student have expressed their satisfaction over the fairness of internal evaluation process by teachers.

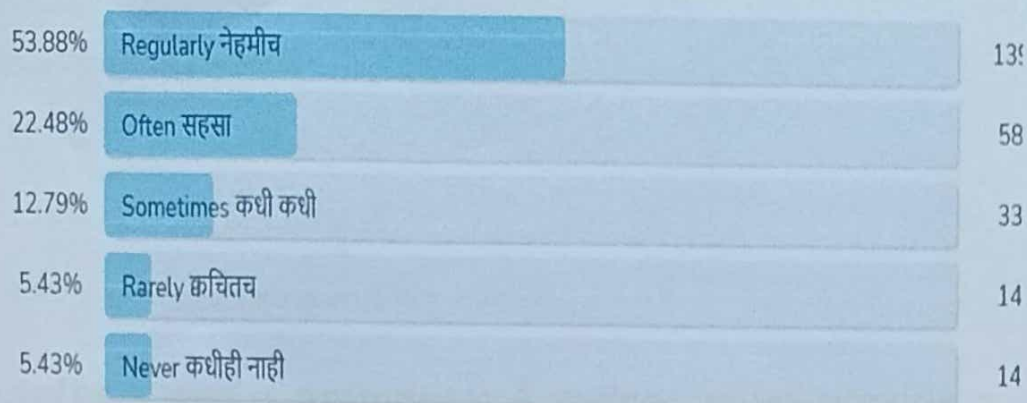
6. Was your performance in the assignments discussed with you?

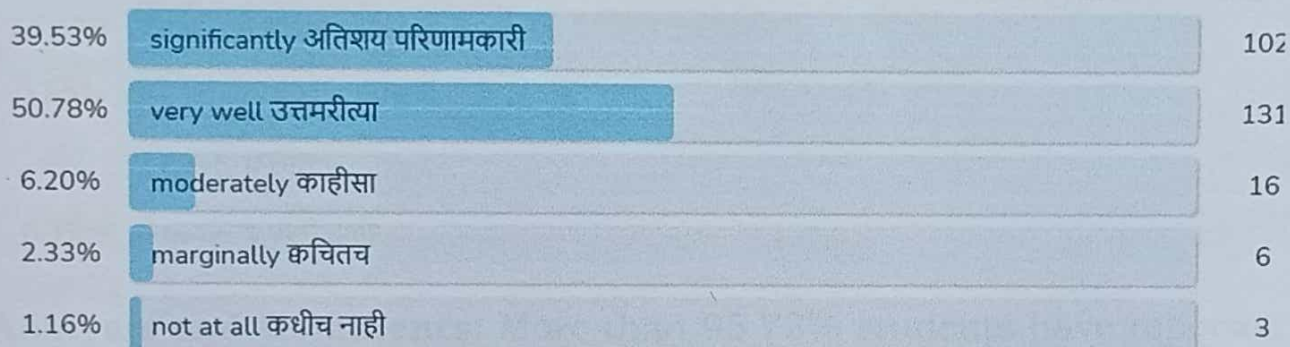


7. The institute/ college takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students:

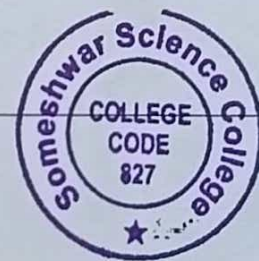


Analysis and Comments: More than 76% students have expressed satisfaction over the promotion of internship student exchange, field visit opportunities. Considering the covid times, it is understandable that the remaining 24% are not satisfied about the efforts of the college in this regard. It is however suggested that the college needs to take vigorous steps to promote internship, it must engage in collaborating with other institute for student exchanges and it must also take efforts to organise field visits of students considering that it is a purely science faculty college.

Analysis and Comments: More than 90% of students have expressed that the mentoring process is implemented efficiently in general sense. However, it is suggested that the college must have a systematic student mentoring programmes along with identification of Weak and Advanced Learners.



9. The college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow

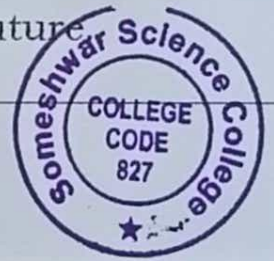

Analysis and Comments: A college must provide a student to grow in multiple walks of life such as academics, cultural activities, sports etc. While replying to this question 53.10% students have strongly agreed that this college provides them with such opportunities while 40.31% have agreed to this and this is a really good score by any means. However, it is suggested that for making the college life more vibrant and lively, the college must plan and schedule a number of events in each academic calendar. This will institutionalize the activities of different clubs like cultural club, sports club, literature club etc.

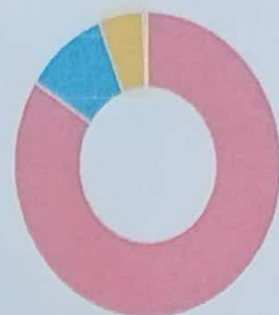
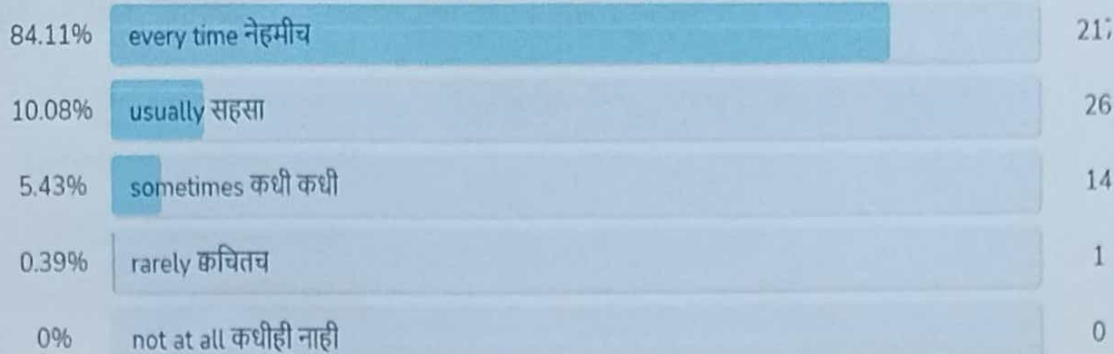
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.

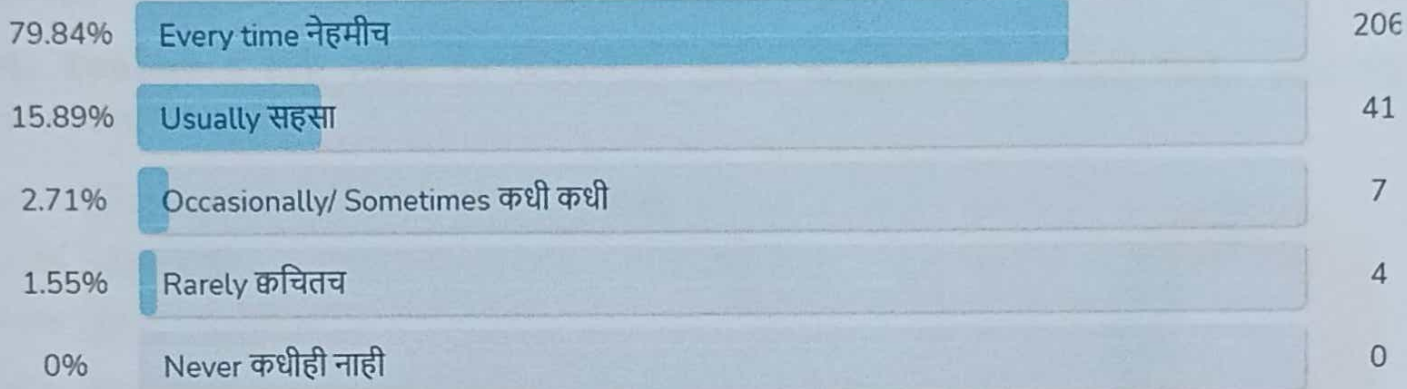


11. Your mentor does a necessary follow up with an assignment task to you

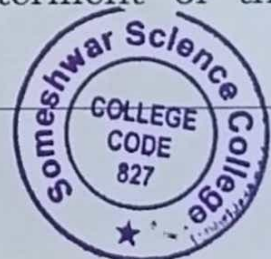

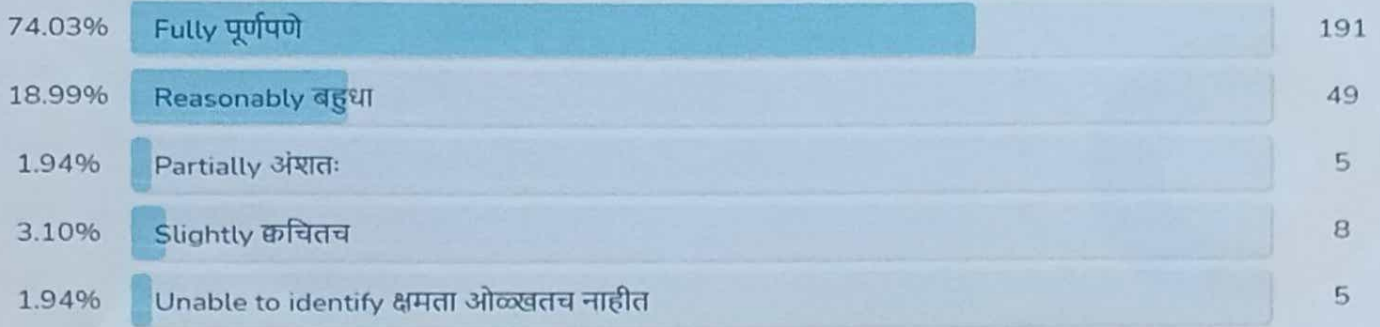
12. The teacher's illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



Analysis and Comments: An overwhelming majority of students have reported that their teachers illustrate the concepts through appropriate examples and also make them aware about the application value of these concepts. It is suggested that for making this more effective, the college must focus on updating the laboratories and equipments so that the teachers can make use of these facilities for the betterment of the students.

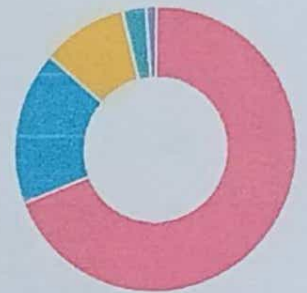
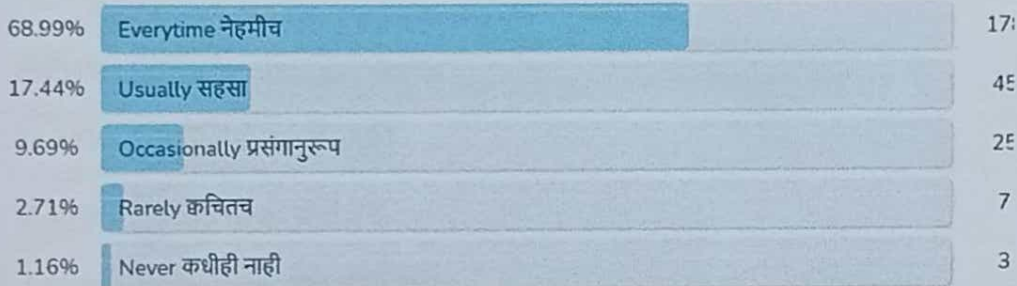


13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges:

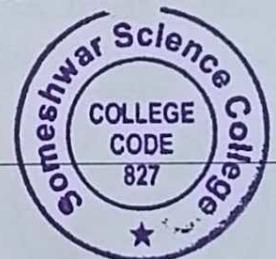

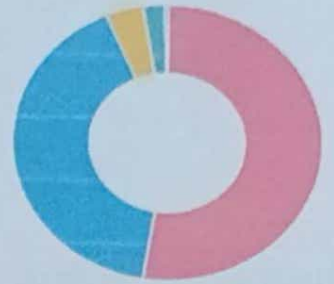
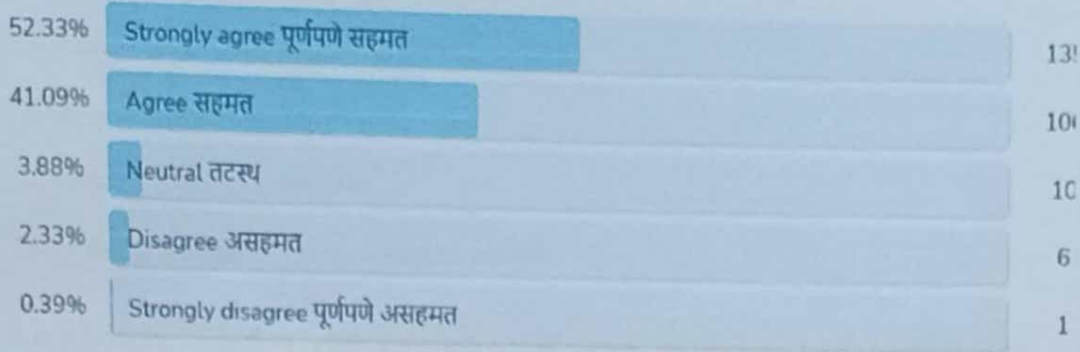
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them



Analysis and Comments: Here, more than 10% percent students have reported that their teachers only occasionally or rarely identify their weaknesses or suggest remedies to overcome them. Though, nearly 70% have reported that their teachers do identify their weakness and help them overcome them, it is suggested that the college must faithfully initiate with the Student Teacher Mentorship Programme. This will help identify not just the weak but also the advanced learners.

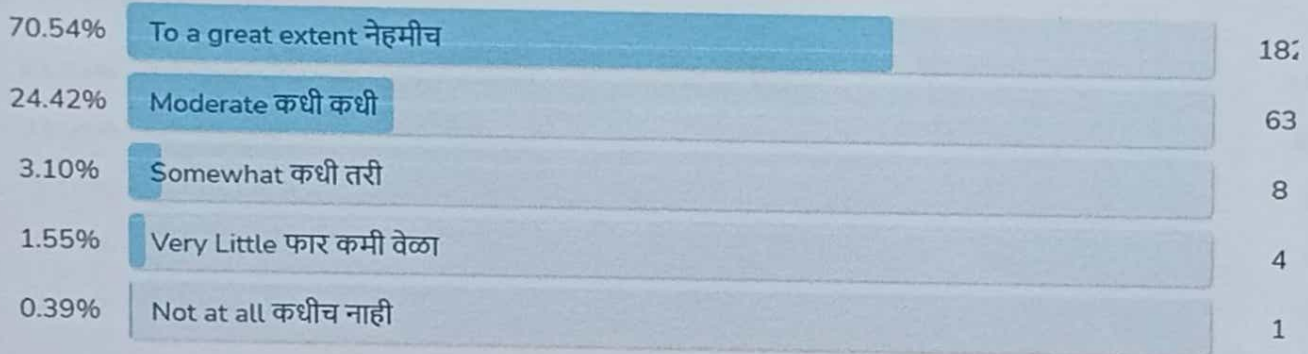


15. The college makes efforts to engage students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

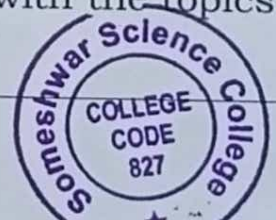


Analysis and Comments: More than 93% students have reported that college takes efforts to engage students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement. This is indeed an achievement for the college authorities. This is the best compliment for the college authorities whose efforts for quality improvements are reaching to the students. However, it is suggested that a suggestion box should be placed outside the Principals Office, where students should be encouraged to put their suggestions and complaints for quality improvement in college.

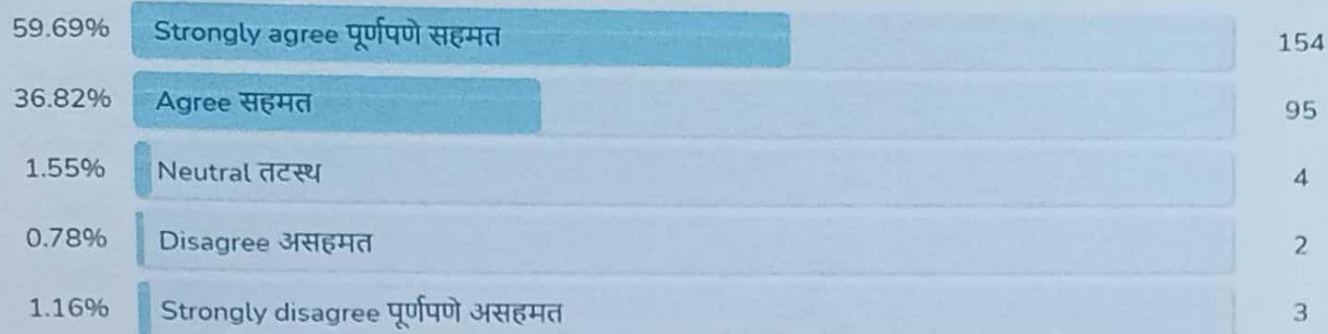
16. The college/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



Analysis and Comments: However, the rest 30% have felt that only moderate or occasional use of these methods is done by teachers. Hence, it is suggested that teachers must be instructed to use such methods often. They should organize field visits, give experiments and research projects to students to work on the problems associated with the topics in the syllabus.

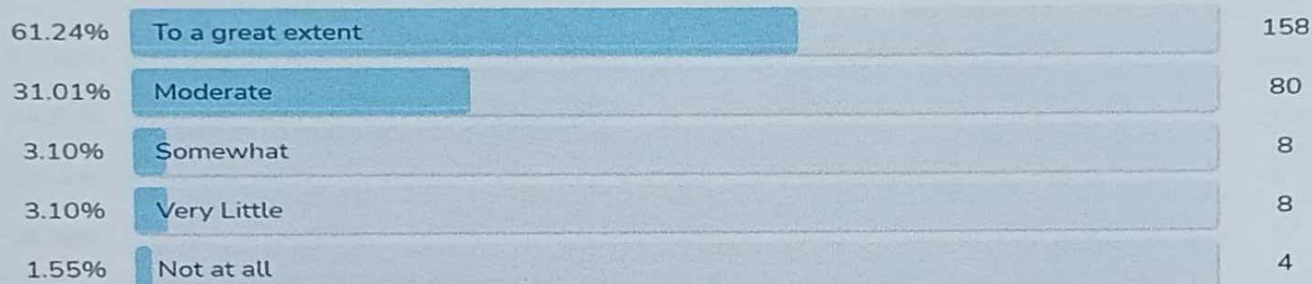


17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extra-curricular activities:

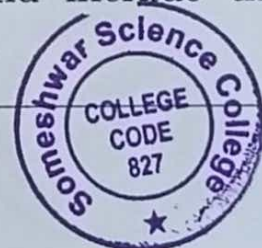


Analysis and Comments: Extra curricular activities are highly important for personality development of the students. For multi dimensional development of the students, it is necessary that teachers encourage students to take part in such activities like Cultural Activities, Dramas, Debates, Sports etc. Regarding this, it is heartening to note that an overwhelming majority of students (more than 97%) have positively reported that their teachers encourage them to take part in such activities. Efforts of the teachers in this regard are commendable. However, some suggestion on this issue is given in general suggestion received from students against the question number 21.

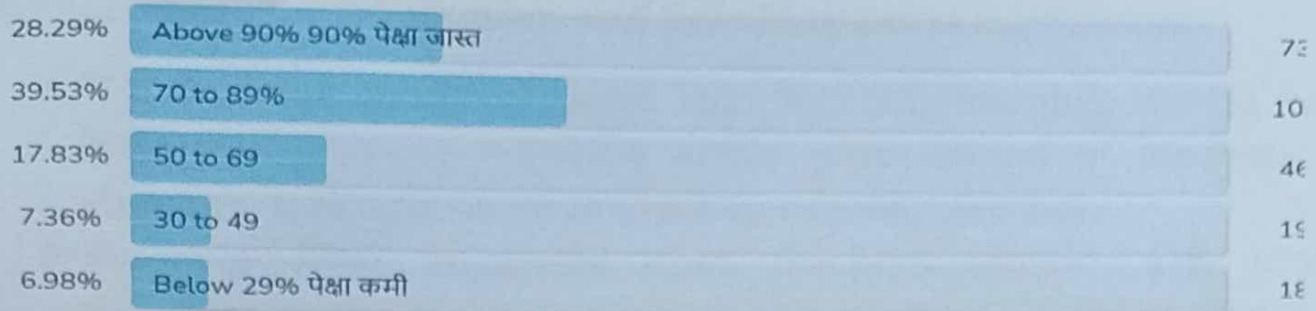
18. Efforts are made by the college for students to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



Analysis and Comments: More than 61% students feel that the college is doing enough to inculcate the soft skill, life skills and employability skills. But the remaining more than 38% students feel that more needs to be done to enhance these skills. It is suggested that a weeklong soft skill programme should be organized each year which should include the workshops on soft skills, life skills and employability skills.

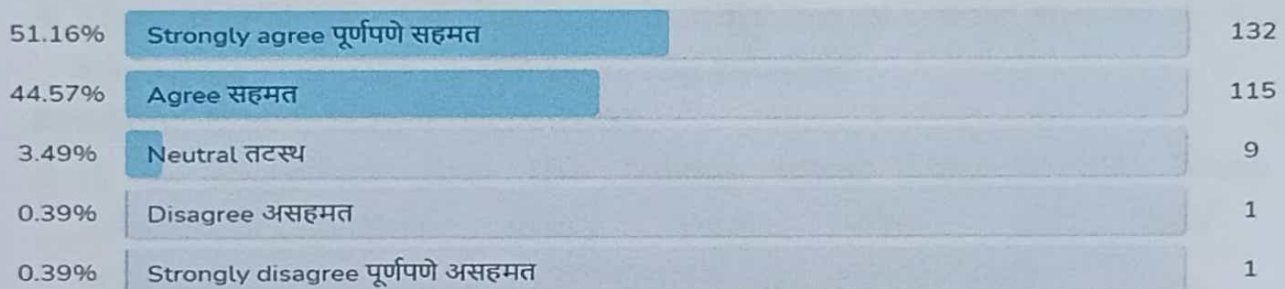


19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching?

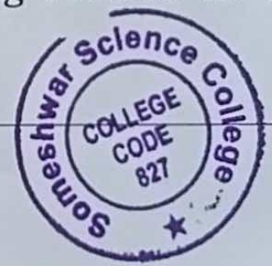


Analysis and Comment: Though, as per the students responses nearly 70% of the teachers are making use of ICT tools effectively, still it is noteworthy that 18% have reported that 30% teachers are not making use of these tools while a 7.36% have reported that only 50% of the teachers are making use of these tools. Considering the online teaching which is in prevalence during covid times, it underlines a fact that at least there is a section of teachers who are not making effective use of these ICT tools. This is also highlighted from the descriptive responses collected in the 21st question. Hence, it is strongly suggested that the Principal and Head of the Departments should identify such teachers. Further, such teachers must be instructed, advised and educated, if necessary, about the use of such resources.

20. The overall quality of teaching learning process in your college is very good.



Analysis and Comment: This question gives you the overall image and impression of the college in the minds of students. Considering the responses, it is satisfying to report that more than 95.60 % students agreed to that the Overall quality of Teaching Learning Process in the college is good.



Analysis of suggestions made by students to improve overall teaching learning experience in your college

Student Teacher Interaction and Teaching-Learning Process

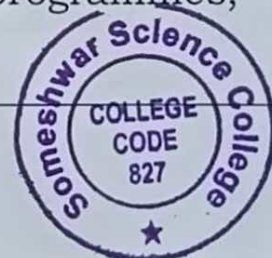
- ❖ The students have suggested that teaching-learning should be an interactive process requiring active participation of teachers and students. It should be an interactive two-way process.
- ❖ Students have suggested that teachers should ask probing questions to check the conceptual understanding of the students.
- ❖ It is suggested that doubt clearing sessions should be kept after completion of every chapter. Teachers should focus on giving more than what is there in syllabus.
- ❖ Teachers should make special efforts to make teaching-learning a participative by making effective use of projects, assignments and interactive learning methods.
- ❖ The students should be given application based assignments where they would be required to use the conceptual knowledge which they have learnt in the class.
- ❖ Good quality notes should be made readily available to students which would enable minimum learning and help teachers to cover the entire syllabus in timely manner.

Use of modern teaching aids

- ❖ A number of students have suggested that classrooms should be equipped with modern methods of teaching such as LCD Projectors.
- ❖ They also suggested that high quality visual media should be used for engaging students in the learning process.

Student Mentoring Programme

- ❖ It is suggested that the college must identify the Weak and Advanced Learners every year based on their past academic achievements, interviews and interactions.
- ❖ For weak students suitable guidance and assistance should be provided to such students through remedial coaching and by assigning such students to mentor teachers.
- ❖ Advanced Learners should be provided higher learning opportunities through collaborations and student exchange programmes, by



participating in various project based academic competitions like 'Avishkar'.

Internship, Collaborative Learning and Placement

- ❖ It is heartening to note that the students have shown great deal of maturity in demanding that college should make available the opportunities of internship which will foster participative and Collaborative Learning.
- ❖ Hence, it is suggested that college should sign MoUs with industries in the nearby area to make the internship opportunities available to at least final year student at UG and PG Level.

Soft Skill Development Programme

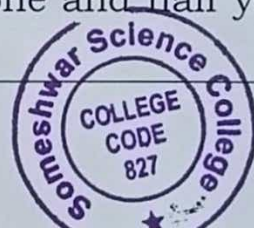
- ❖ The students have expressed satisfaction over the Soft Skill Development Programme which is conducted by the college.
- ❖ It is suggested that Spoken English Workshops, Personality Development Workshops, Interactions with motivational achievers should be organised occasionally to boost the confidence of the students.

- ❖ In the new terminology, the name of Library is now changed and it is called as the Knowledge Resource Center
- ❖ We all are aware about the need, role and importance of a good library in developing the culture of self learning
- ❖ It is strongly suggested that the library should be equipped with the best possible reference books, books for competitive examinations and Journals
- ❖ The good quality text books should be regularly updated
- ❖ Occasional Programmes should be organised for teachers and students by library for creating awareness about online resources like INFLIBNET, National Digital Library, and NPTEL.
- ❖ Most importantly, it is suggested that the college must ensure that peaceful reading rooms are made available for students. This will add a great deal in creation of academic culture in the college.

Cultural Activities and Extra Curricular Activities

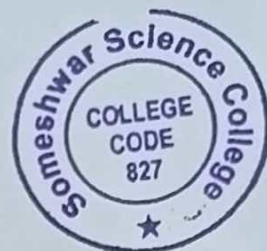
- ❖ Considering the near house based learning in last one and half year the importance of Cultural Activities is highlighted.

Sports

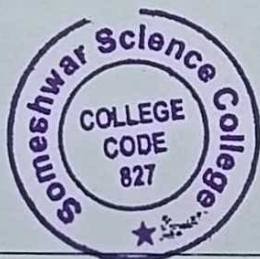
- ❖ During the lockdown, everybody has understood the importance of health and fitness.




Your Opinion Matters!
