

infrastructure.

system in the month of 10th to 13th March, 2025. This study involved Undergraduate of


Science, computer science and Post Graduate students of organic chemistry faculty. Total 216

Students participated actively in this survey. Results are as follows:




Gender: 216 responses






1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the class?




Analysis and comments:


3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

4. Teachers approach to teaching can be best described as:




Analysis and comments:

Nearly 80 % of the students have expressed that the teachers approach towards teaching is very good. This gives idea regarding commitment of the teachers towards teaching.




5. Fairness of the internal examination process by the teachers.



Analysis and comments:



6. Was your performance in the assignments discussed with you?




Analysis and comments:


7. The institute / college takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

8. The teaching aids and mentoring process in your college facilitates you cognitive social and emotional growth.




Analysis and comments:

suggested that the college must have students mentoring programs along with identification of weak and advanced learners.


9. The college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.






Analysis and comments:


11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.






Analysis and comments:

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




Analysis and comments:

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.






Analysis and comments:

Nearly 84 % students have reported that their teachers do identify their weakness and hello them to overcome them. College have initiative with the student teacher mentorship programme.


15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

16. The college/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.






Analysis and Comments:

They should organize field visits, give experiments and research projects to students to work on the problems associated with the topics in the syllabus.

Analysis and Comments:

Regarding this, it is heartening to note that an overwhelming majority of students (approx. 91%) have positively reported that their teachers encourage them to take part in such activities Extracurricular activities are highly important for personality development of the students. For multi-dimensional development of the students, it is necessary that teachers encourage students to take part in such activities like Cultural Activities, Dramas, Debates, Sports etc. Efforts of the teachers in this regard are commendable.




18. Efforts are made by the college for students to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



Analysis and Comments:

More than 91 % students feel that the college is doing enough to inculcate the soft skill, life skills and employability skills. 19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching?






Analysis and Comment:
